




IGNITE – LEARNING TO CROCHET A BAG

THE PROCESS OF LEARNING AND REFLECTING


STARTING OUT

- Today I was collecting the materials that I need for crocheting. I decided to buy a thicker wool because as I am still learning to crochet, it will be easier to handle and I can see if I make mistakes. By next week I hope that I start crocheting a square that will go towards my final product but I still need to get a crochet hook.



JULY 9

- Today my grandma brought me some of her crochet hooks to use and she also taught me how to make a basic square. After I used a video to learn how to make a more complicated square and I didn't manage to finish the square today so I will finish it tomorrow.



JULY 10

- This morning I finished the square and I am very happy and proud of it so I think I will use this in my final product. At the moment, it is a bit difficult to remember what kind of crochet stitch each row needs but I think I will manage to learn it after crocheting a few more squares.



JULY 21

- By the end of today I have finished a total of 9 squares. For my bag I am thinking that I will do 6 squares on each side so I think I will do 12 squares in total. I am still deciding how I want to make the handles/straps but I am aiming to finish the squares first.



AUGUST 14

- Today I finished all 12 of my squares but when I put them together, it didn't look right so I have decided I am going to do 9 square each side so I have to crochet 6 more squares.



AUGUST 24

- Today I ran out of wool but I am unable to buy more because we are in lockdown and the wool that I need is out of stock. I still wanted to crochet so I started making a small square but as I gradually extended it I decided that I wanted to use this as my bag strap so I can work on this while I am waiting to get new wool




SEPTEMBER 1
